

Registration Process

You must register **each** year by completing a new “Application for Membership” and signing the “Training Agreement and Waiver of Liability”. All forms and fees must be submitted in order to train. No exceptions!

- Step 1: Complete an “Application for Membership”.
- Step 2: Sign and date the “Training Agreement and Waiver of Liability”.
- Step 3: Review the session and fee schedule below. Make cheque(s) payable to **Woodbine Karate Club** and please include student name(s) on cheque(s). Also include a separate cheque for a \$10.00 non-refundable administration fee.

An additional charge of \$25.00 will be applied for cheques returned as NSF.
- Step 4: Complete a “JKA Membership Application”. Membership is **mandatory** and is required for rank examinations. It also provides insurance in case of injury during training classes or competitions. The annual fee is \$25.
- Step 5: Submit all forms and fees to Yuri Isakovich at the Woodbine Karate Club.

Note: Affiliate memberships (JKA, KAA), gradings, uniforms, belts, tournament registration fees and special events are not included in the session price.

- Session One: September/October/November
- Session Two: December/January/February

◆ Fee Schedule

- Adults (18+) \$186.00 per session or one annual payment of \$650.00 (savings of \$94.00)
 - Youth (8-17) \$170.00 per session or one annual payment of \$550.00 (savings of \$130.00)
 - Kinder (5-7) \$130.00 per session or one annual payment of \$450.00 (savings of \$70.00)
 - Family Full price for first adult or youth member, 10% off second member, 20% off third and no charge for fourth or subsequent family members.
